- ★ Discussed/debated campus security issues locked doors, metal detectors, teachers w/ licensed-to-carry guns, etc.
- ★ Looked into and recommended participating in the SuperGoop! Ounce by Ounce sunscreen program for Pre-K thru First grade; and after approval by Mr. Stahnke, received a free large pump bottle of mineral sunscreen SPF 40 for the 16 classrooms (pre-K thru 1st) for students (and teachers) to use during recess or any outdoor activities. This program promotes skin cancer awareness and prevention.
- ★ Recommended bringing Rachel's Challenge to the JH campus. It is a well-received and award-winning program promoting kindness, accepting uniqueness and differences in each other and preventing bullying. (It was presented at the HS campus about 10 years ago).
