## Comanche ISD Athletic Policy

- 1. **Tobacco, Alcohol, vaping, e cigarrettes, juuling, and non-therapeutic drugs** are not allowed to be used in our program. Any use of these products will be subject to disciplinary action.
- 2. **Theft**: Taking things that do not belong to you will not be tolerated. The person caught may also be prosecuted by law.
- 3. **Conduct**: We expect our student athletes to be the leaders of the school district. We expect our young women and men to act first class at all events. The Comanche Maidens and Indians will be known for how they play the game and behave on the court or field. We will praise our opponents and play beyond our ability. At Comanche ISD, we will always conduct ourselves as ladies and gentlemen, including class time. Failure to adhere to the above will result in disciplinary action or possible suspension.
- 4. **Ejection from a game**: Will result in running after practice is complete. UIL rule states that players ejected will miss the remainder of the game and possibly future games.
- 5. **Attendance:** Do not be tardy to class. If you are going to be absent from athletics or school, we expect a phone call or email informing us why you will not be attending. The coaches of each sport will have the right to determine the make-up for missing practice or games.
- 6. **ISS**: A student who is sent to ISS for behavior will have extra conditioning and they will not be allowed to participate in any extracurricular competitions on those days while in ISS.
  - Example: Johnny gets sent to ISS for improper conduct in Coach Hermesmeyer's class and he is assigned two day of ISS. Johnny goes on Thursday and Friday but will not be able to play on Friday night because he was not in regular class that day.
- 7. **Promptness**: Always be at school, practice, or games on time. The trip bus will not wait for you. If the coach says we are leaving for Dublin at 7am then make plans to be here by 6:45am so you will not miss the bus.
- 8. **Dress:** We will dress professional in uniform and out. Everyone will wear the uniform in the same manner. We will follow the Comanche HS and JH dress code. No earrings or piercings for young men at athletic events, school, or activities that occur on school grounds. Caps will be worn forward and not backwards while on school grounds or at events.
- 9. **Quitting:** Athletes who quit a sport will not be allowed to start another sport (practice or competition) until the end of the season of the sport they quit. If an athlete is participating in two or more sports at once and wants to quit one of the sports, then she/he will have to quit all sports unless it's a mutual decision by the coach and the athlete. All athletes will be given a two-week probation period to try out the sport before it is considered quitting.

## Comanche ISD Athletic Code

The Comanche ISD Athletic Code was written to establish a consequence if an athlete breaks a rule in our policy. We hope this never happens; however, if this does occur, we will administer to the prescribed discipline. We ask that our athletes work hard to follow our athletic policy. Athletics is a privilege, so please uphold the great reputation that Comanche ISD portrays.

\*\*\*A student being investigated for committing a felony of any type will be suspended from all extra-curricular activities until the charges are dropped or dismissed.

1<sup>st</sup> Offense- 15 miles of running (only 4 miles per day allowed, must be observed by a coach) Parent notification, one- week suspension from all contests involved in. The player can travel with the team but will not participate.

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense- 30 miles of running (only 4 miles per day allowed, must be observed by a coach). Parent notification, Conference with parent and student. Miles must be completed before competition resumes.

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense- Will result in suspension from all athletics for one calendar year.

\*\* Running must be done before school or after practice (not during the athletic period or practice time)

The Athletic Director and Head coach will determine if an athlete may re-enter a sport in season.

If the offense occurs while school is not in session, the punishment will start once school is back in session.

Examples include but are not limited to: Vaping, MIP, MIC, DUI's, DWI's, Burglaries, Serious misdemeanors, felonies, unlawful acts, ect. Students receiving a citation, caught in the act by school personnel or admit to the behavior will be subject to the above penalties.
